

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

STATE OF New York }  
COUNTY OF Wyoming } ss:

On this 18 day of January, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and Seven personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and State aforesaid, Mary A. Gallup, aged 70 years, a resident of Portageville, County of Wyoming State of New York, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the act of Congress approved June 27, 1890, as amended by the act of May 9, 1900.

That she is the widow of Lyman B. Gallup, who was Enrolled under the name of Lyman B. Gallup at LeRoy on the 26 day of December, 1861 as a Private in 105th New York Vol. and honorably discharged July, 1865 having served ninety days or more during the late war of the rebellion. That the soldier was not in the military or naval service of the United States except as stated above.  
(If any other service it should be stated in full.)

That she was married under the name of Mary A. B. not to said soldier at Stamford, Vt on the 17th day of February, 1852 by Edid Hall, J. P.; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage; that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had not been previously married.  
(If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated.)

That the said soldier died October 29th 1906 at Hunt Livingston Co., N. Y. that she was not divorced from him; that she has not remarried since his death; and that she is without other means of support than her daily labor and an actual net income not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars per year.

That the said soldier left the following-named children who are now living and under sixteen years of age, to wit:
