

DEATH OF FORMER ST. CHARLES RESIDENT

Mrs. Johannah Anderson Peterson was born March 15, 1845 in Sweden and came to this country when a young girl. She married Albert Peterson and they came to St. Charles about 80 years ago and live on a farm about a mile east of the city. Eight of their nine children were born on this place. They later moved to a farm about 3½ miles farther east on what is known as the Theirs farm, where their youngest child was born.

In 1901 the family moved to Mt. Lake in Cottonwood county where they homesteaded and where Grandma Peterson had since made her home until last August when she became unable to do her household work any more. She was moved to a hospital in Mt. Lake where she died on January 10, at the age of 103 years.

Mr. Peterson died in August, 1908. Two sons, Alfred and Charles also have preceded her in death.

Survivors are one daughter, Mrs. Eda Small, St. Charles and six sons: Willma, Hempt, Calif.; Ernest, Somers, Mont.; George, Glendale, Arizona, Richard, Ortonville, Minn.; and Herman and Frank on the home farm near Mt. Lake.

Also 89 grandchildren and great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at Mt. Lake, Friday and burial in ~~Mt.~~ Lake Cemetery.
