

Mrs. C. F. Peterson *april 12* Dies at Age of 69 *1939*

Mrs. C. F. Peterson, 69, formerly Lillian B. Small passed away at her home at 6 p. m. Wednesday. Death was attributed to influenza and a heart attack.

She was born in St. Charles township February 13, 1870 and was married to Charles F. Peterson December 24, 1892. Shortly after their marriage they moved to Mr. Peterson's farm home in Delton Township, Cottonwood county, near Mountain Lake, Minnesota. Here they resided until Mrs. Peterson's health began to fail her and they retired in 1931, when they returned to St. Charles and have since lived here.

To this union two children were born, one daughter, Mrs. Myrtle Wilaby, and one son, Raya, who preceded his mother in death in 1926.

Mrs. Peterson is survived by her husband; her daughter, Mrs. Myrtle Wilaby, Mountain Lake; one sister, Mrs. William Pfeil; one brother, Charles Small both of St. Charles and six grandchildren.
