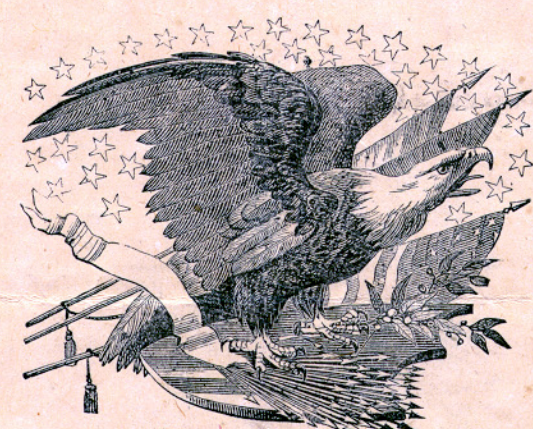

# To all whom it may Concern.



Know ye, That William Small -----  
a Corporal of Captain Norman Buck's -----  
Company, (D.,) 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Minnesota Infantry  
**VOLUNTEERS**, who was enrolled on the Fifteenth day of August  
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Two to serve three years or  
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States  
this Sixteenth day of August, 1865, at Ft Snelling  
Minnesota by reason of Telegram A. G. O. dated Aug. 11<sup>th</sup> 1865  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)\*

Said William Small was born in Ireland  
in the State of -----, is Twenty One years of age,  
Five feet Four inches high, dark complexion, dark eyes,  
black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer -----
